


All the time/

We focus on the physical sharing because it allows you to really feel the closeness of a distant one that you love and miss when you are alone somewhere.





Why Hug?

Psychological effect of hugging and other senses...

Hearing

Rich in feeling & emotion. Sound of a loved one's voice can be enough to create feelings of comfort & joy.

Seeing

Seeing is believing. Human face & body communicate a lot of meaning and emotion.

Touching

Humans need physical contact with each other.

Infant sink into depression & die without it.

Adults deprived of tactile contact for long period will tell you just how depriving it feels.

A hug, handshake, a pad on the back, and a kiss are all important.

Smelling&Tasting

Scent of perfume, hair, clothes and skin smell brings us very **close** to others.

Smelling stirs up powerful emotional reactions.

Smell & Taste are primary ways an infant connects to its mother


Often tradițional holdings are better than the brand-new ones......

What do you expect from a hug?

The other person doesn't smell bad (Oscar)

Could be very very warm; almost hot (Simona)

Commitment to the whole hug going all the way through it (Dianna)

Warmth, a warm fuzzy feeling (Dianna)

I expect to hug person back, and be able to hug and smell and touch, feel the person, for me it's not that than being hugged is important but other that I can hug back (Natasha)

I want to feel a real hug, not a formal one (Mario)

Warmth, radiation of live energy (Stijin)

I don't expect anything from a hug because when I'm hugging I just interested in giving whatever like in (Deepak)

A lovely feeling (Bill)

Make me feel happy, safe, loved, at least. It is like alone for second like a private moment (Livia)

Full body contact (Sock puppet)

Strength, warm, avvolgente (Laura)

Pleasure, passion, warmth, the sensation of being precious for someone (Francesca):







What do you feel when you hug someone?

Happy (Oscar)

Strength? I have to **communicate** something that suddenly urged me. **Unstressed**, calmer, happy, **accepted** (Dianna)

Heat, warmth and softness of the body (Mario)

Depends on person. If I hug Deepak, it's all right... (Stijin)

There are too many feelings. It gives a very content feeling, sense of security and it makes you feel wanted (Deepak)

I have better feelings when I hug my old friends when I meet them after 2 or 4 years, we do each other and laugh around a bit (Rajesh)

Makes me realize that someone likes me (Shyama)

Depends on person. But usually, lovely feeling (Bill)

Happy and warm. I love to hug (Livia)

I feel close, intimacy and pleasure (Laura)

If I hug a friend I feel very happy and I am trying to communicate to this someone to let that person feel comforted in a way.

If I hug someone that I **love**, I want this person to feel how much he is **important** for me (Francesca)



Usually whom do you hug?

Men, close **girlfriends**: In Portugal, you give **two kisses** and hug any of your friends, so it's normal for us to hug but it's not like very strong hug (Natasha)

My girlfriend (Stijin)

I hug Natasha three times a day (Rajesh)

Normally I don't go hugging myself but I accept hugs (Shyama)

Karen, my wife, my friends. I got used to hugging a lots of people including other guys. Because that is normal in California (Bill)

I hug a lot of my girlfriends and everyone in my family (Livia)

My friends, my mom; boyfriends, and I used to hug my grand father a lot (Francesca)

How was your longest hug ever?

I don't think I have done anything that demands to too many hours unless you think of **sleeping** together as being a hug. But I don't think that is really a hug. That's **more** of it (Bill)

Must be very long. Sometimes, you hug when you are sleeping (Livia)

Longest hug was maybe when something very strange thing happened to me either something very beautiful or something very bad (Laura)

When I sleep with someone, I love to put my arm around him, we slept almost 8 hours like that. (Francesca)









Which kind of hug do you prefer?

Good one, strong one, around my waist here (Natasha)

A hug beating on the back (Mario)

Total confronting full-body hugs. A hug on the back of my girlfriend when she is doing something. A normal hugging but more contact (Stijin)

A full body hug. I don't like a soft hug (Rajesh)

A.hug completely tight (Syama)

One that I get from Karen every time I see her (Bill)

Should be like **strong** and long hug. Shouldn't be too fast (Livia)

It depends on the person's height (Livia)

When someone hugs me, I love to be kept around my back or waist strongly. I like to feel someone hands on the back of my neck (Francesca)

Where do you usually put your hands?

Right around one's shoulders (Bill)

Put arms and hands on one's back. When I hug Magnus, I just hug his stomach (Livia)

Depend on height of person. Around someone's waist or shoulders (Laura)

Around someone's waist, neck (Francesca).





What do you think happens inside and outside of your body during you hug someone?

Maybe some harmonious stuff about these **hormons** which makes you feel erotic, which gives you **comfort** in a direct trigger way.

Those are enough there that affects everybody in sense of way, just some extent, so probably it is just a basic physiological phenomena. (Bill)

I get all this **positive** chemical things going on. I get relaxed and happy and **feel good**. (Livia)

My muscles are relaxing. Endorphin. I have a sensation of warmth especially if outside is cold. (Laura)

There is something like a **chemical reaction**, a lot of hormons going around my body. I feel euphoric, happy and special pleasure that make each part of your body become **hot** at the same time. Lalso feel something like **waves going up and down**. (Francesca)

When do you need a hug?

Almost all the time. It's kicking my life going any time (Bill)

I need hugs in the morning. Also when I am tired, sad or stressed. (Livia)

Often. For reassurances (Sock puppet)

Always. But specially, when I am sad (Laura)

When Lam stressed. Hugging someone is like putting all my stresses down to the ground (Francesca)



What do you think someone feel when he or she hugs you?

I don't know (Simona)

I hope I am hugging them in the way that someone feels the same way that I do (Dianna)

I hope the person feel some affection in a very good way (Stijin)

I make the person feel absolutely at home and I know it (Deepak)

Must be **feeling nice**: I am a nice guy (Rajesh)

I guess, they are **very instantaneously expressed** (Shyama)

Warmth of embrace, cosiness, security, comfort, and pleasure (Bill)

I want someone to feel warm, loved and safe and closeness (Livia)

Necessary just from the front, also I like to try to hug behind (Nat)

I think words don't fit to describe hugging (Stijin)















Do you want to say something else about hugs?

Hug is good for you. Please hug people. (Oscar)

It depends on the height of the person. If somebody might higher or shorter, probably I feel more comfortable that I like around shoulders. If the men is taller than me, there are two kinds of hugs, either his arms are around my shoulders and I am around his like that. It's completely different if he is taller than me and I have my own shoulders on his shoulders. I like both, equally (Dianna)

I sometimes particularly in public and if I don't know someone very well, I feel awkward about hug or I don't really want to hug at the moment.

But normally if somebody I feel comfortable with it, doesn't matter if it is public or **private** (Dianna)

Strong **physical contact**. Have to consider more about persons attitude who are not used to hug other people (Mario)...

A hug from a very good friend it is like a real nice bear?? hug (Deepak)

Please hug me (Rajesh)

Hugs are a part of making you feel comfortable (Shyama)

It is a wonderful way of getting to know someone. When you hug them, you can see the heart of person that you've never seen before (Livia)

Yes, please (Bill)

Research on materials, fabrics, shapes

Materials

Soft and elastic material that naturally fits one's skin, Lycra by Dupont

Fluffy material that makes people feel like cuddle, positions of human body where are sensitive to subtle warmth and pressure

Kind of clothes

Underwear; evening gowns

Sporty, streetwear look or evening embroidered houte couture looking

Kind of look

Embracing clothes, **glamourous** patterns inspired by Japanese Obi belt or Renaissance hard corset.

Cool materials and wearability of extreme sports clothes, easy to wash, lightweight is a must, the sensation of wearing must be left aside, you wear something beautiful but so comfortable you can't notice you're wearing it.



Designing F+R Hugs Ideas and sketches development diary

Interviewing possible users to define keywords about hugs, and **positioning** of the hugs on the body, physical and emotional reactions studies, **testing prototypes**


4th week

5th week


Final prototype ready, defining advantages, business opportunities and ways to technologically implement the project as future step.





Sharing emotions concept

Scenario

Kelly is at home in Paris (alone), her boyfriend Peter left for a meeting in Sweden. She decides to go out for some workout in the Jardins deLuxemburg and she wears the Sport Hugs underwear (just in case). While she is training in the park she runs a lot thinking at Peter so distant, she really misses his warm hug, so she decides to send an input to him: a tender soft hug. After few minutes finally Peter that already has received her hug since he was wearing too his Hugs underwear, at the end of the meeting could send her a hug back, he sends a lovely intense strong love hug, she could feel his hertbeat and breath and warmth is like having him there for real.

The prototype

Protection for your **Body:** padded sections in delicate body parts silicon+gel bags

Protection for your Feelings: now you can feel

Touch

Warmth

Heart Beat and Breath

How the Hugs project works

The Hugs bodysuit that looks like a sporty cool underwear allocates in the red circled areas silicon bags containing the output devices connected between them thanks to the small wires channels (following the dark gray stitchings)

On the wrist is allocated the detachable input/receiver device, so the user could send the hug also without wearing the complete system but only carrying out the input/receiver.

The positioning of the **silicon bags** around the waist is ergonomically compatible and the positioning of the input device on the wrist makes possible to manipulate the system through **natural gestures**:

That makes the **Hugs System** completely mudular, costumizable and controllable by users:



Hugs project description

Hugs T-Shirt

Its a lilac Eycra T-shirt, with silk screen printed red circles and dark gray contrast stitchings.

Will be perfect to implement also the clothes aspect using **seamless** technology.

Under each red circle there is a pocket where could be allocated an output bag/device, the output device could also be used to protect the body during sport activities thanks to its silicon soft bags.



Between each pocket there are connection channels for wires, wires must be thin and transparent.

In case of use of **UMTS** protocol wires will not be placed.

Pockets are placed on the **back**, **neck**, **arms**, **waist** and wrist, the pocket on the **wrist** will allocate the **input** device to send hugs.

Input and output devices


Hugs input

The input device is composed by various sensors and its **task is to check and transmit** information to the output device.

The information to check are: body temperature, heart beat rate, hug strenght of the person that sends the hug.

the information to send are **heart beat rate**, breath; **temperature** and **pression**.


That info are detected by a **termistor**, a **stetoscope** and by a **pression** sensor, the system is working when the EL paper is lighting up.





The output device is composed by a soft silicon bag, an heating pad, a ballon inflated/shrinked by a microoscillating pump, paper speaker and EL paper lighting since the fabric is semitransparent creates a pleasant pulsation effect sinchronized with the hb rate of the sender. The output function is to receive the input information and modify values and physical aspect of the different electronic devices. The heating pad receives the input to became warm as the body temperature of the sender, the speaker transmits the sound of the heartbeat, the balloon inflates an makes pressure as the hand of the sender, when the balloon shrinks you can really feel the hug going away.









The prototype Next steps to implement the project

Real Time Sharing

To fit the **Real Time Emotion** Sharing concept, our next step will focus on the application of a wireless technology using the **UMTS** protocol, so to have a device able to **send and receive** hugs without pushing buttons or activating sensor, to let the communication be more **natural** around the **world**.

Fit different users

To fit the needs of **different users** will be available several different **style versions** (fabric, decoration and so on) sport, evening, outfit etc.

Realastic sensation

To let the pressure sensation be more real we found out the right technology a microoscillating pump; electronically controlled that will give the perfect hug strenght.

To read also other tasks should be preferable to find more sensitive sensors and make some tests with Muscle Wires.

Or instead of having a pump will be interesting to reasearch a new kind of gel that inflates when is warm and shrinks when is cold....

We want also work on movement rechargeable batteries, on having a switch mode to let you decide when you want to be connected, and a screaning procedure for upcoming hugs.
